

CONCORDIA NURSING STUDENTS CAN AGAIN USE OLLI'S HELP

Linda Murphy, wife of OLLI presenter Dr. Bob Murphy and instructor at the Concordia University Nursing School, has again asked OLLI members to partner in seeking healthy adult



volunteers over 70 to allow nursing students to conduct a health assessment. Last year's group from OLLI had a wonderful experience.

Date/Location: Wednesday, August 10th from 1 until about 3:30 PM at the school's Park Place campus near Jamboree and Michelson. Each volunteer will meet with 3-5 students who will ask them questions about their health, medications, any chronic diseases, etc., and then they will do a head-to-toe assessment. No invasive procedures -- just listening to lungs, looking in eyes, ears, mouth, palpating abdomen, those types of things.

Critical Eye: Movie Reviews



THE FAMILY FANG

Distinctly *odd ball*, this film unspools as a comic/ ragedy. Jason Bateman and Nicole Kidman convincingly play brother and sister.

The screen is mostly dark or low lit, deliberately washing everything in a moody remembrance. What is art? Can you deliberately involve your family in the making of your performance art and not expect them to ever question your genius? Based on a book by Brian Wilson the characters and ideas expressed are intriguing, but not quite mainstream. In fact, sometimes the film seemed like a spooky kids story. Nevertheless, it's an intriguing film you ought to see.

Young director Elena Rossini took eight years to craft this mirror on the media, exposing the absurd, humorous and shocking images of men and women enslaved to unattainable self-images. If you didn't catch it at the Newport Beach Film Festival or OCMA, look for it online.

In these volatile days of dirty tricks - left, right and center- it is enticing to leave it all behind and view an 18th century story of grace, charm and manners in "ye olde England." Wait- more dirty tricks? Have humans no heart? Based on a very early Jane Austin novella, it is revealed as a scheming story of bite and wit with a feminist bent. Admittedly, the pacing is a bit too stately, but it's good to slow the heart rate down now and then.
