




Exhibit | Inside Reading Minds: Grunigen Medical Library RxEAD Posters, 2006–2020


UPCOMING Exhibit | 400 Years of Shakespeare's First Folio

Published in 1623, Shakespeare's First Folio was a landmark of printing at the time and, as of 2020, is

the most expensive piece of literature ever auctioned. Printed seven years after Shakespeare's death, the First Folio was the first compilation of his plays, 18 of which had never been published before.

Abstract: Srinivasa has been focusing on deploying robotics and AI in fulfilment, first at his startup Berkshire Grey (2014-2018), and then founding and leading the Robotics AI organization at Amazon (2018-2022). You receive packages at home today that have been manipulated or transported by his robots. This lecture will present some of the challenges in perception, continual learning, motion

planning, and control. We will discuss solutions to date and the technical gaps that need addressing. We will also talk about lessons learned scaling robotics and Al worldwide to thousands of systems.


