

We at OLLI are proud that we gave Edgar Moran a vehicle through which he could exercise and demonstrate his authentic scholarship. Edgar felt much gratitude toward us as well for being that vehicle. Edgar possessed an impeccable passion for research, creativity, learning and teaching, all of which was patently obvious to anyone who knew him or learned from him.



Some of us at OLLI referred to Edgar as a "Renaissance Man". How coincidental it is that one of his best courses was on the art of the Italian Renaissance, a class which our OLLI featured twice within 2 years. His original profession was medicine and he taught in the Medical School at UCI. 






Exhibit | Inside Reading Minds: Grunigen Medical Library RxEAD Posters, 2006–2020



UPCOMING Exhibit | 400 Years of Shakespeare's First Folio

Published in 1623, Shakespeare's First Folio was a landmark of printing at the time and, as of 2020, is the most expensive piece of literature ever auctioned. Printed seven years after Shakespeare's death, the First Folio was the first compilation of his plays, 18 of which had never been published before.

Research Speaker Series The CurQD Protocol

Wednesday, May 24 12:00 PM - 1:00 PM Free via Zoom

The CurQD protocol is a natural, adjunct therapy for IBD developed at Sheba Medical Center,

Israel, by leading GI researchers, Nir Salomon and Professor Shomron Ben-Horin, who have been researching evidence-based nutraceuticals for Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis for the past 15 years. In the lecture, Nir will present the recent evidence from both real-world experience and RCTs with the CurQD protocol in IBD including mounting data showing that CurQD is a unique agonist for the aryl hydrocarbon receptor in the mucosa, leading to intestinal reconstitution and mucosal healing. The lecture proposes a new integrative strategy that can be easily implemented into clinical practice to help improve remission rates and long-term maintenance in IBD.

Ecology has become generalized. With relations as foundational, things start to disintegrate. Beings become
